For: Region 11 (Metro area) cued language transliterators, transliterator trainers, cued language transliterator mentees/mentors, students of cueing.

Prerequisite: Ability to cue

Description of three day workshop:

Course I provides an overview of professional standards of practice, helping participants gain the knowledge and skills that they need to do the best job possible. Exercises, explanation, and discussion address a variety of topics, including: expressive cueing proficiency, receptive cueing proficiency, transphonation, Auditory Environmental Stimuli, ethical decision making, paraphrasing and summarizing, and more. Additionally, participants will be shown exercises designed to help them practice on their own outside of formal training opportunities.

Course II provides highly concentrated exercises, allowing the participants to focus their efforts on a few of the many skills which must be in the cued language transliterator's repertoire. This module is designed to address several of these skills in more depth, including: expressive cueing proficiency, receptive cueing proficiency, and paraphrasing.

Presenters: The two Language Matters Inc. instructors are nationally certified cued language transliterators who have special training in cued language transliterator education. Each instructor specializes in several topics found in a given module. You'll benefit from their combined knowledge and skills in all phases of education, including: lecture, evaluation, diagnostic feedback and discussion.
